Social Communication Intervention for Children With Autism Who Have Delayed Language

Your child may be eligible to participate if he/she:

- Has a diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder
- Is between 3 and 4 ½ years old

Participants will receive:

- Assessments of language and cognitive skills at no cost to you
- Evidence-based communication intervention at no cost to you

What we will ask you to do

- Come to Vanderbilt Kennedy Center for assessments six times throughout the intervention
- Fill out forms telling us about your child's development
- Children will participate in 2 sessions per week in the clinic and 1 session per week at home with their parent
- Total time commitment is about 7 months
