Modeling simple sentences about what children are noticing and doing helps them learn new words and how to form sentences.
You can comment on...

What an object is doing

If a child...

Pretends to feed a babydoll

Looks at a ball rolling down a ramp

You could say...

"The baby is eating"

"The ball is rolling"

Where objects are going

If a child...

Pushes a toy down a ramp

Pushes a train under a bridge

You could say...

"It went down"

"The train is going under"

How something changed

If a child...

Finishes their juice

Fills a bucket with sand

You could say...

"The cup is empty"

"It is full"

What an object is

If a child...

Reaches for a train

Watches a ball rolling down a ramp

You could say...

"Train"

"A ball"



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
